Bucha. Lacrimosa by VICTORIA VITA POLEVÁ

Bucha. Lacrimosa was written in response to the terrible atrocities committed by Russian armed forces that took place in Bucha in spring 2022. Of the piece, Polevá says: "After seeing the atrocious acts and crimes committed in those photographs, I burned with despair and my world changed forever. I started writing Bucha. Lacrimosa to survive. Bucha's ashes strike my heart."

Symphony No. 9 in D minor by Ludwig van Beethoven

The Ukrainian Freedom Orchestra's performance version of Schiller's great poem "Ode to Joy," sung by the soloists and chorus in Ukrainian, and captured in the recent Deutsche Grammophon recording, follows in the tradition of another remarkable cultural and historical gesture. On Christmas Day 1989, just weeks after the fall of the Berlin Wall, Leonard Bernstein conducted Beethoven's Ninth Symphony in the city and made one important change to the text. Bernstein altered Schiller's opening word "Freude" (Joy) to "Freiheit" (Freedom) and in so doing defined a moment of hope in German, and world, history. In making her performance version, the orchestra's founder and conductor, Keri-Lynn Wilson, working with her Ukrainian musical colleague levgeniia lermachkova, changed "Freude" to "Slava" (Glory), from the phrase that has become familiar around the world as the rallying call of Ukrainian resistance in the face of ruthless Russian aggression, Slava Ukraini! (Glory to Ukraine!).

The orchestra's performances of the new performance version were the first time the symphony's text had been presented in translation outside of Ukraine. A concert in Warsaw, the occasion of the Deutsche Grammophon recording, was followed by a performance in Berlin on Ukrainian Independence Day, August 24, 2023. The orchestra and soloists were joined by 40 singers made up of Ukrainian refugees and other residents in Berlin. The concert was attended by the Federal President of Germany, Frank-Walter Steinmeier, in a public show of support for Ukraine's fight for its freedom. Wilson subsequently took this version of the symphony back to Ukraine and performed it in Lviv in December 2023 with Lviv National Opera.

## UKRAINIAN FREEDOM ORCHESTRA

The Ukrainian Freedom Orchestra was formed in 2022 by Canadian-Ukrainian conductor Keri-Lynn Wilson in direct response to Russia's brutal invasion of Ukraine. Working in collaboration with the Metropolitan Opera in New York, the Polish National Opera in Warsaw and the Ukrainian Ministry of Culture, Maestro Wilson brought together an ensemble composed of leading Ukrainian musicians from inside the embattled country, as well as recent refugees and Ukrainian members of European orchestras. Its explicit mission was to defend Ukraine's cultural legacy as the country fights for its freedom. It has been under the patronage of Ukraine's First Lady Olena Zelenska since 2023.

The orchestra's summer tours have included some of the most prestigious venues across Europe and the United States such as the BBC Proms and the Barbican in London, the Concertgebouw in Amsterdam, Hamburg's Elbphilharmonie, Lincoln Center in New York City and the Kennedy Center in Washington DC. This year's tour sees them perform at some of the great cathedrals and concert halls on both sides of the Atlantic as well as a special concert in the Polish shipyard that was instrumental in the birth of the Solidarity movement. The Ukrainian Freedom Orchestra is proud to have showcased contemporary Ukrainian composers alongside the greats of the wider European musical tradition and has enjoyed a rapturous and emotional public response, critical acclaim and unprecedented media attention for an artistic venture of this kind.

#### SONGS FOR UKRAINE CHORUS

The Royal Opera House's Songs for Ukraine Chorus was established in spring 2023 in response to Russia's invasion of Ukraine. Made up of 160 Ukrainian people, a majority of whom have been displaced by the war, the Chorus celebrates Ukrainian culture and resilience. The Chorus are proud to donate their time and effort in support of Ukraine, its people, cultural heritage and artistic development, and members range from seasoned professional singers to people taking part in a classical music concert for the first time.

Formed as part of the Royal Opera House's Creative Exchange programme, the Songs for Ukraine Chorus, performing alongside members of the Royal Opera Chorus, demonstrate the power of music to inspire hope and solidarity. Appearances to date have included a Christmas concert at Bradford Cathedral and concerts at the Royal Opera House, the US Embassy Commemoration Gala at the Palace Theatre, and media features both nationally and internationally on CNN, BBC Radio 3 and ITV.
