



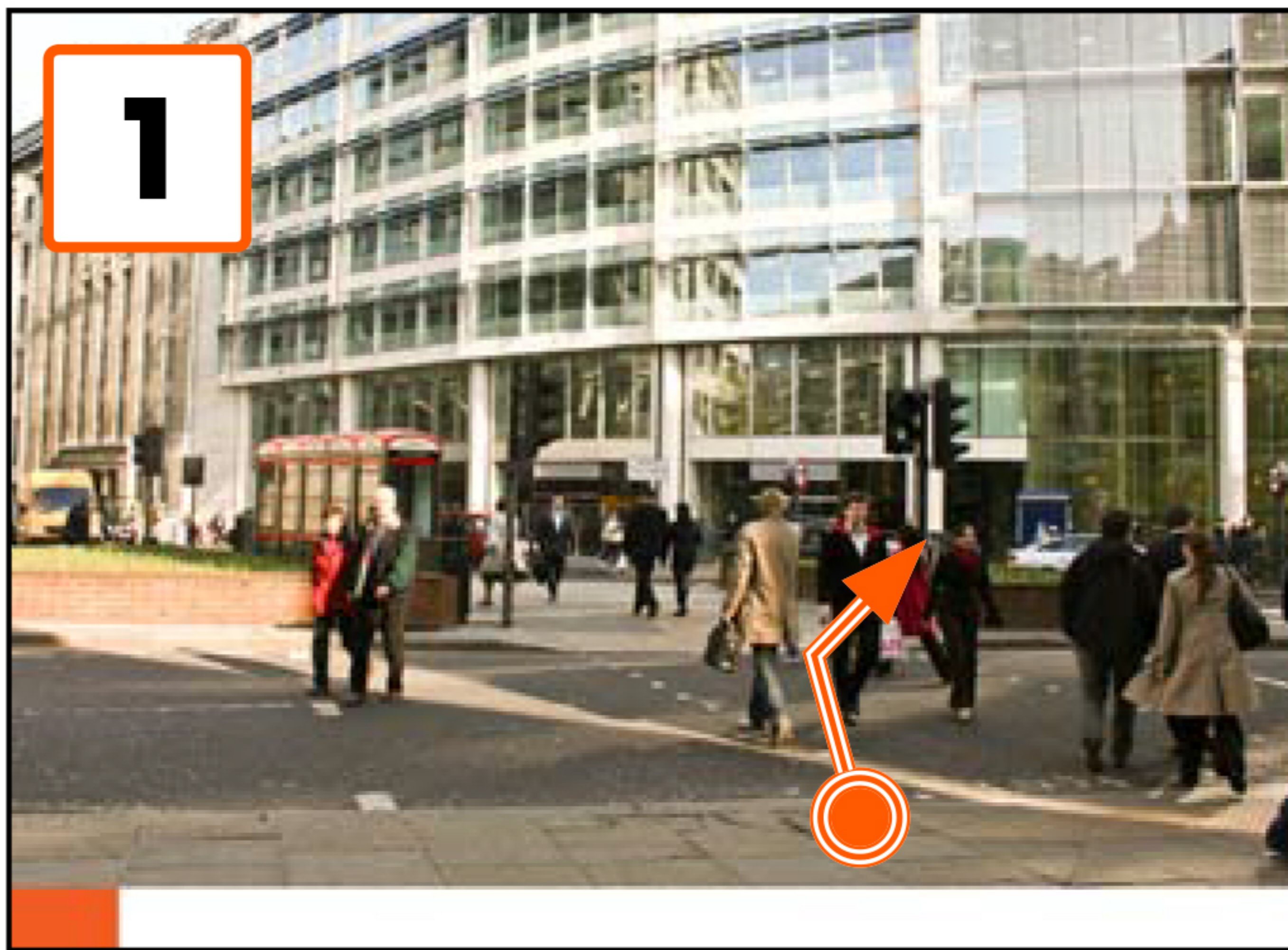
This map takes you from St Pauls Underground station to the lifts on the 2nd floor of the Barbican.

The journey is around 850 metres long.
It should take around 15 minutes to finish.
If you have difficulty getting about, it could take 30 minutes.

Under each picture is a time-bar to show how much of the journey there is to go.

-  = the length of travel for each part of the journey
-  = the length of travel already completed

From St Paul's station cross over Newgate Street to the traffic island then cross over Cheapside. If you arrive by tube take Exit 1 signposted Cheapside, Museum of London, Barbican then follow from Picture 2.

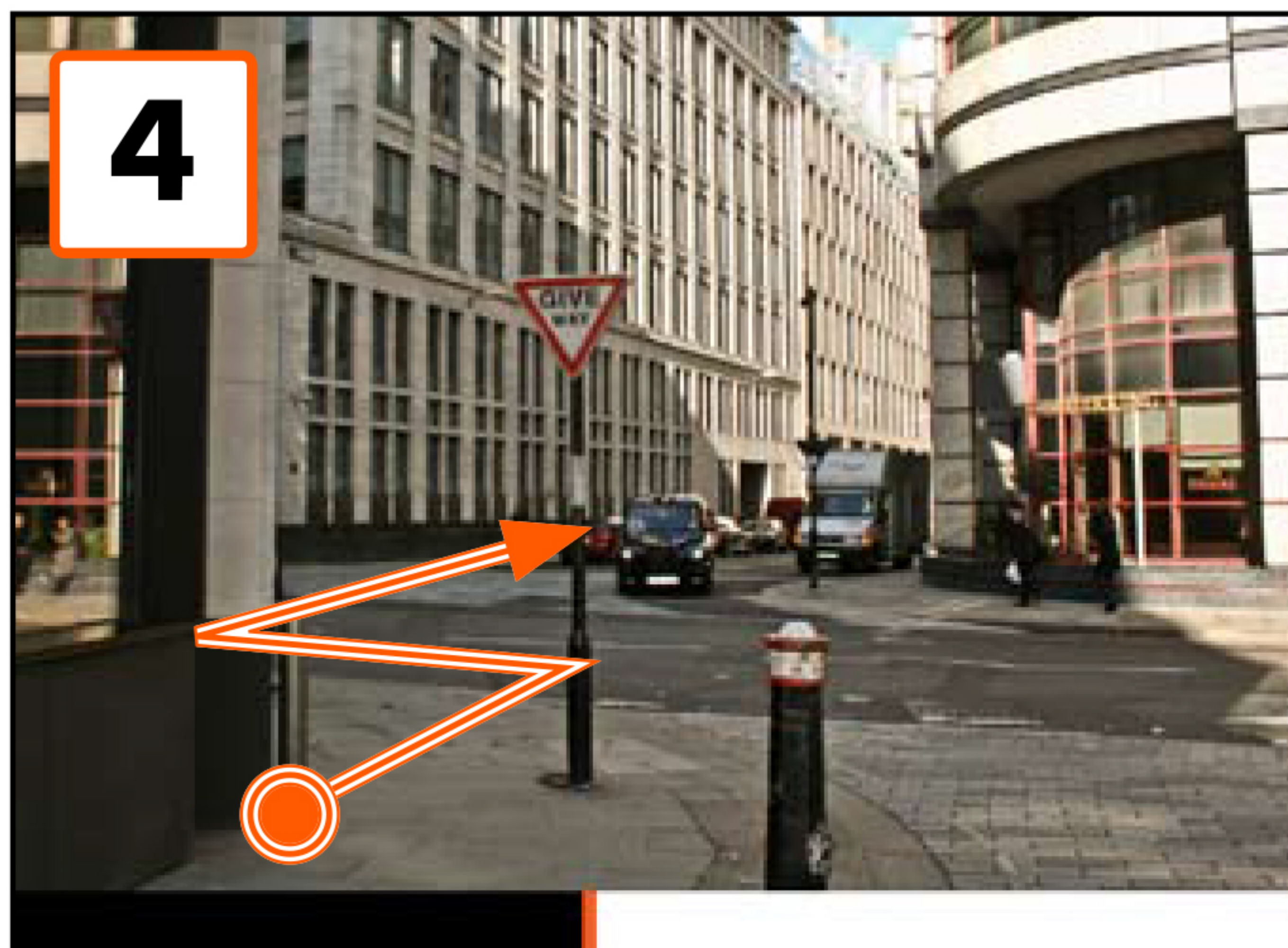


Turn right on Cheapside and travel down on the left hand side. You will pass Foster Lane and Gutter Lane on your left.

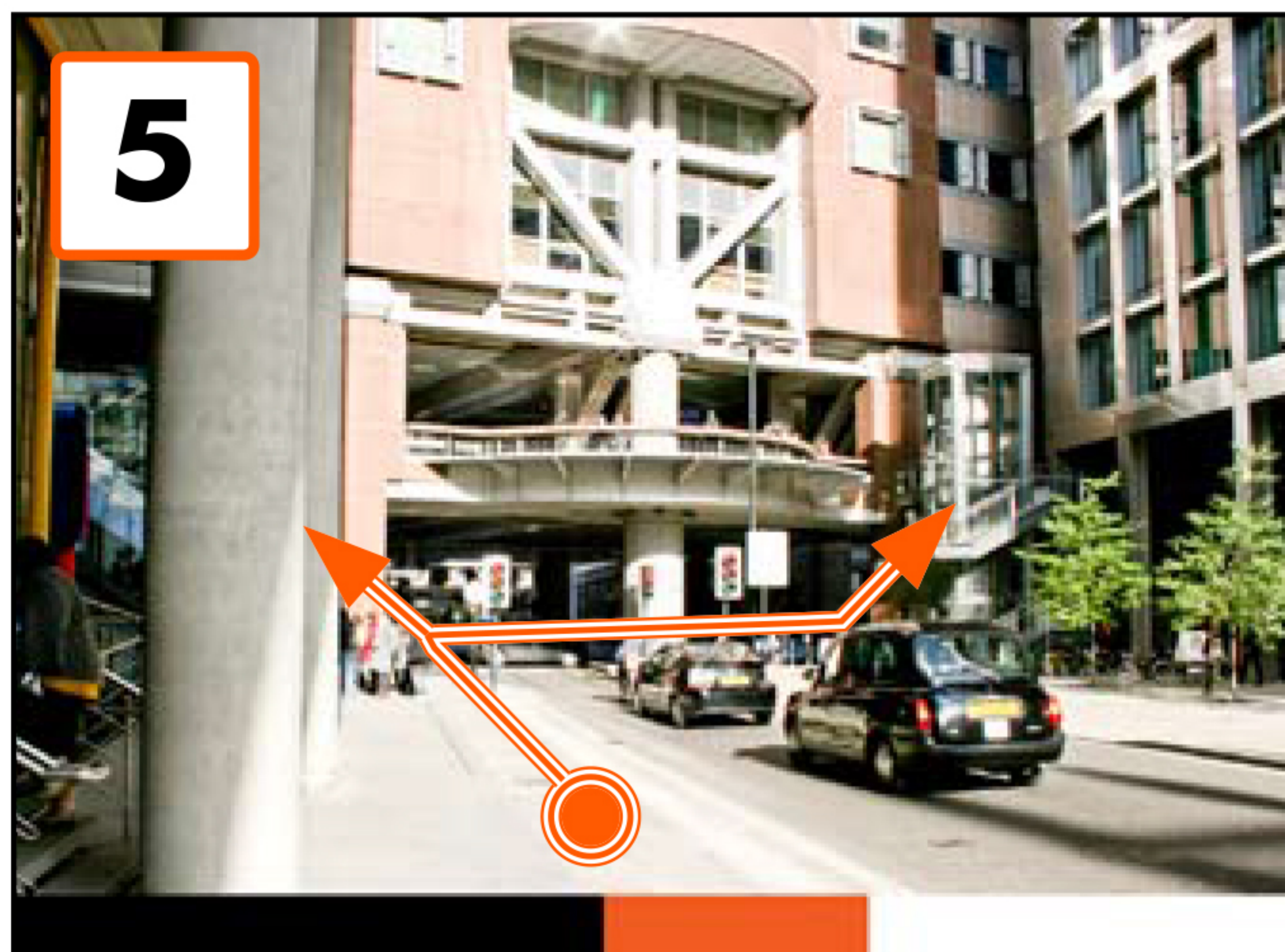

The next left is Wood Street, turn here and continue ahead.

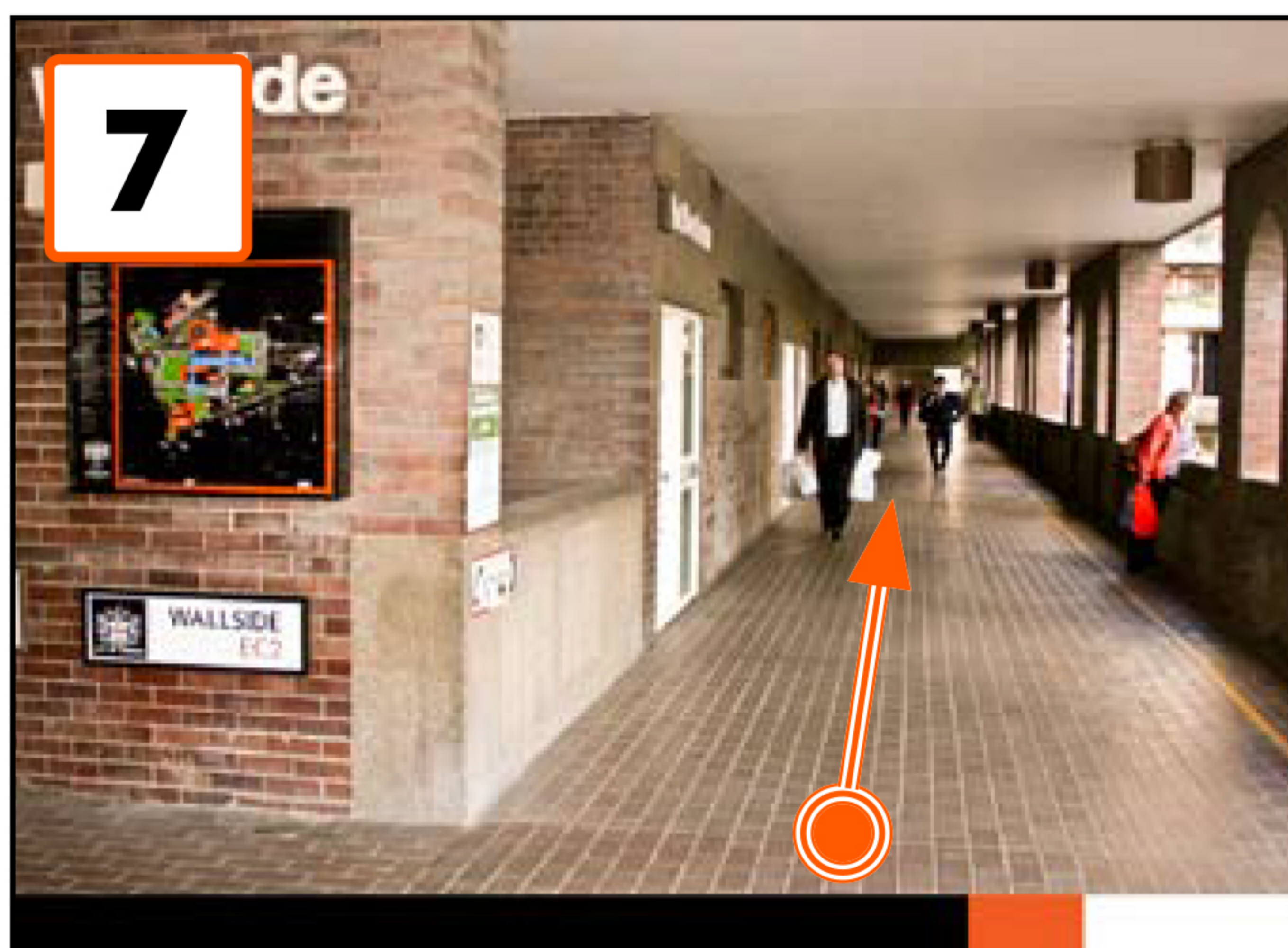
At Gresham Street, Wood Street continues ahead. Turn left and cross over at the dropped kerb and continue along Wood Street. You will see a tower ahead of you.

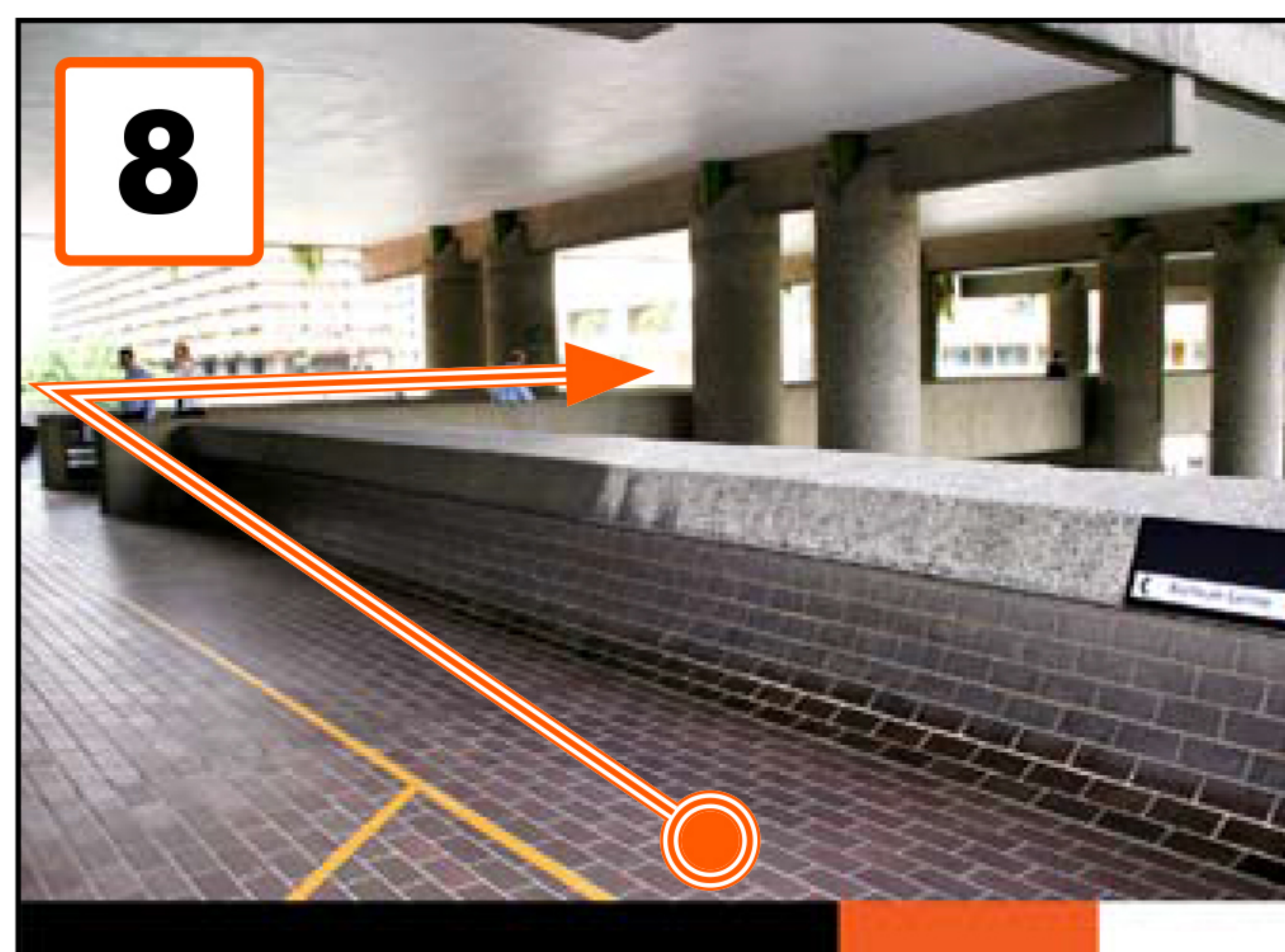
Continue to the traffic lights. You can take the escalator on your left or the lift / stairs / ramp behind the lift on your right up to Alban Highwalk.

At the top continue ahead following the yellow line between the two pizza restaurants. Travel straight along Alban Highwalk.

Continue onto The Postern (Highwalk).

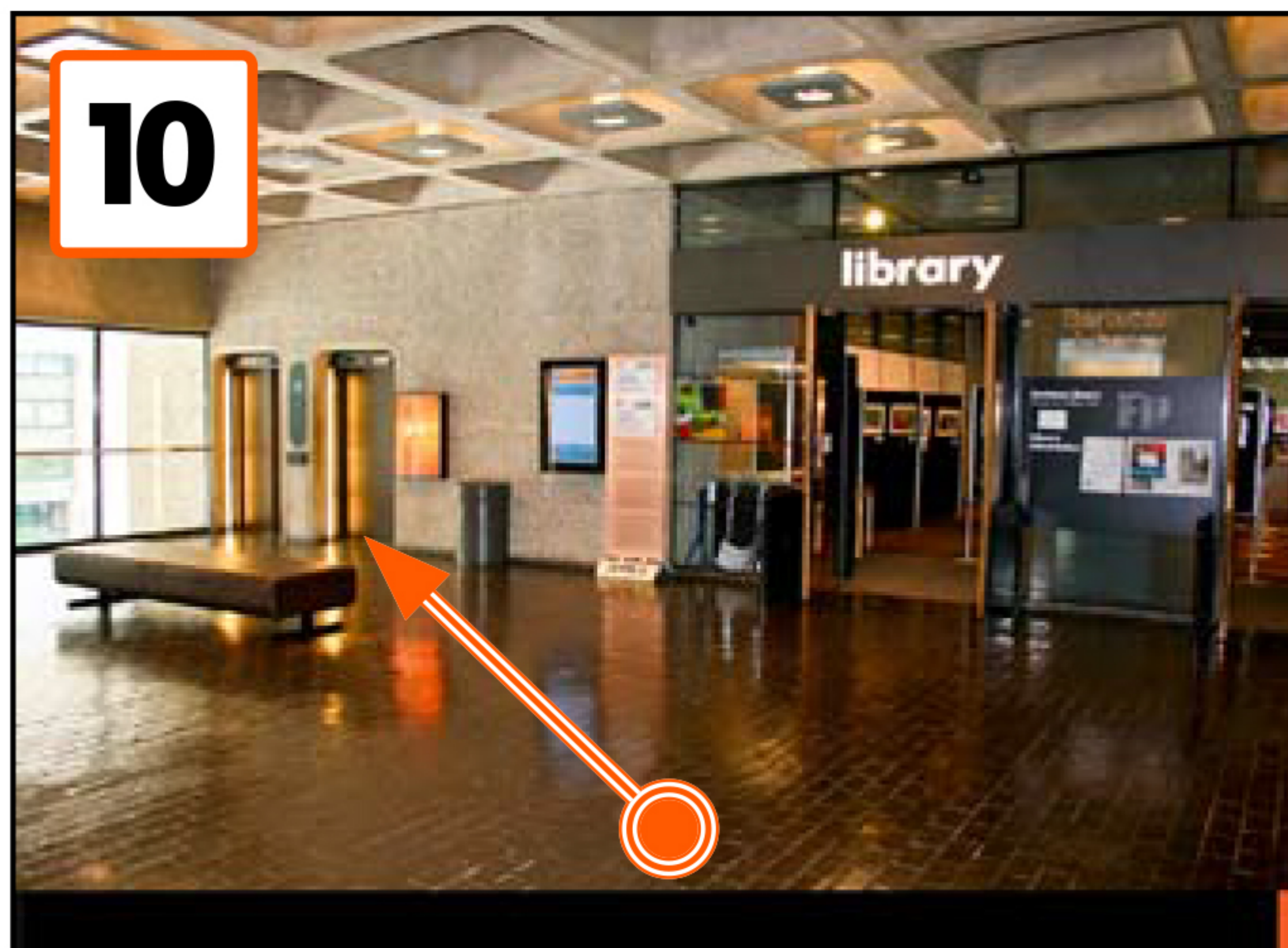

Turn left onto Andrewes Highwalk. You may be able to hear water flowing. Turn right and go over Gilbert Bridge by the corner of Andrewes Highwalk.

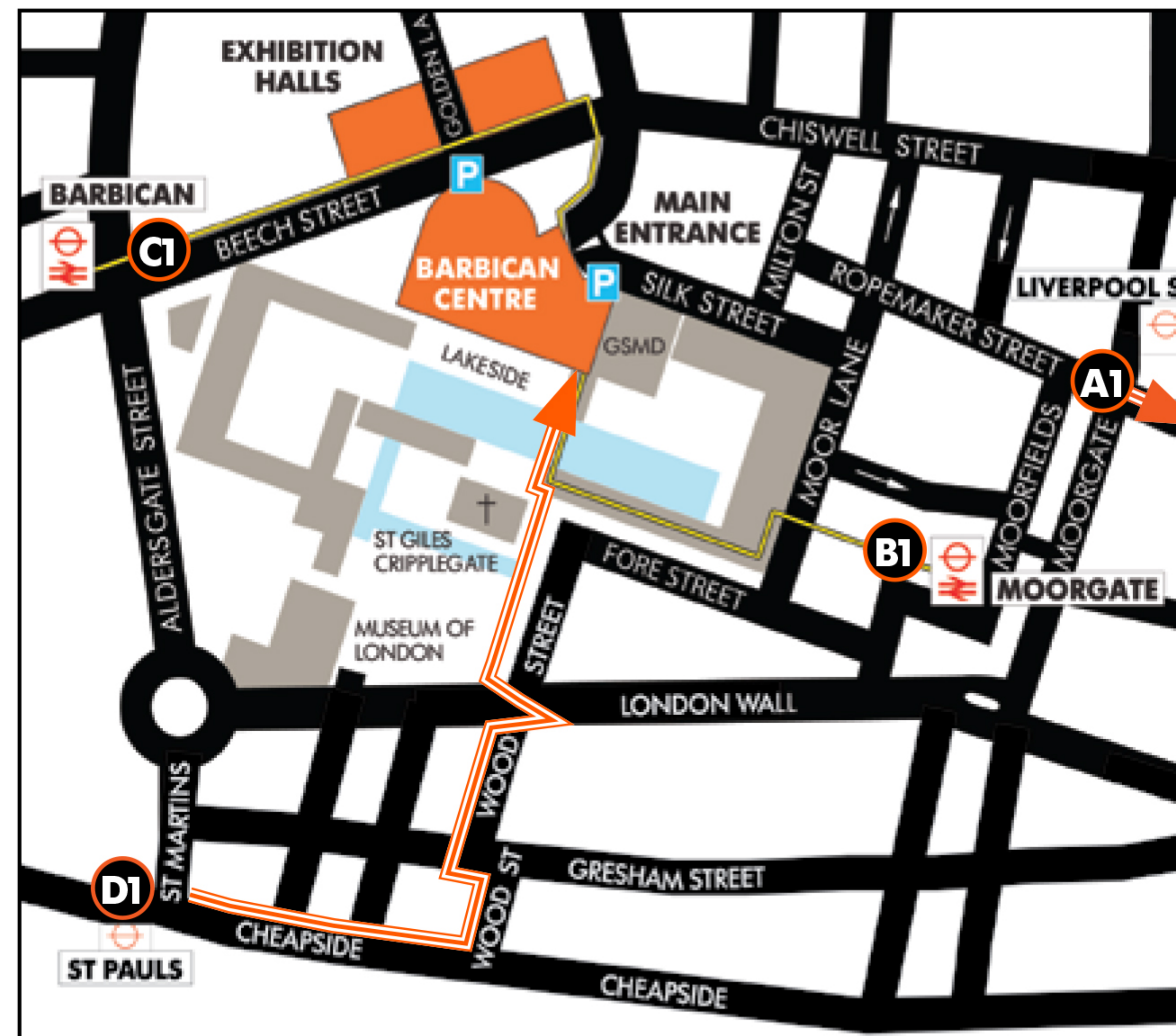

At the end of Gilbert Bridge take the first walkway on the left. Go through the automatic double doors towards the library at the end.
