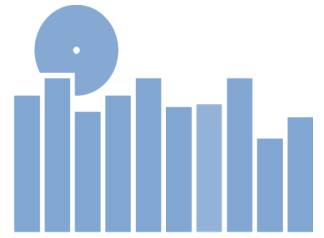

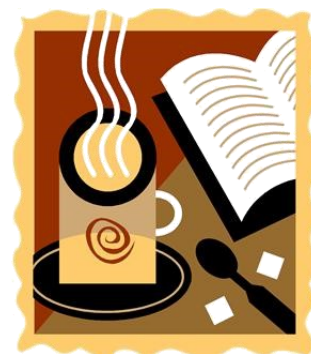
## REGULAR EVENTS
