Frequently asked questions

Straight from the score and onto the stage, the man known as Mozart appears amid a storm of powder, tumbling and twirling, as musical mayhem and movement fuse in this family show with a circus twist.

This performance is most suited to families with children aged 3 years and older.

How long is the show and what should we expect?

The performance lasts approximately 50-60 minutes. This is a story about three friends who have a magical time together at a birthday party, with lots of music and acrobatics. As this performance is relaxed you may leave the theatre at any point during the performance and are free to pop back in

When you arrive in the foyer please check bags and coats into our free cloakroom.

Barbican staff will be available to provide assistance during the performance to ensure audiences can relax and enjoy the experience.

The café-bar will be open throughout, serving a range of teas, coffees and snacks to enjoy in the foyer. We request that you don't take food or drink into the theatre. You can consume food and drink in the Pit Theatre foyer before and during the performance.

Where will we sit?

You will sit on the provided seats in the seat number marked on your ticket. You may be close to the action so we request that you keep children from going onto the stage area.

What is a relaxed performance?

The performance on 19 December at 11am will be a relaxed performance. This means it will be suitable for children who have physical, learning, sensory or communication needs. A **Chill-out space** will be available in the Pit foyer should you need to leave the performance. You can pop back in at any point.
