
What's On in the Library January 2019

View the latest collection of desirable objects by two skilled makers from Teddington which includes ceramics, art and furnishings. These artists bring strong influences of their respective Italian and Brazilian homelands to their work, resulting in design objects that have a very appealing and distinctive style. **Carmela Kantorowicz** is always exploring new forms to see how they complement different decorative techniques. This results in new collections of stoneware and porcelain vessels bringing fine design to your kitchen table. Her raku pieces similarly make wonderful statement pieces for display in any interior setting. **Stephanie Wilkinson** has a penchant for creating large acrylic landscape and still life paintings with vibrant colours and patterns, as well as compact pen drawings. These translate beautifully into limited edition prints, vegan suede cushions, cards, and coasters. Silver plated pendant jewellery and fabric designs are new for 2019.
