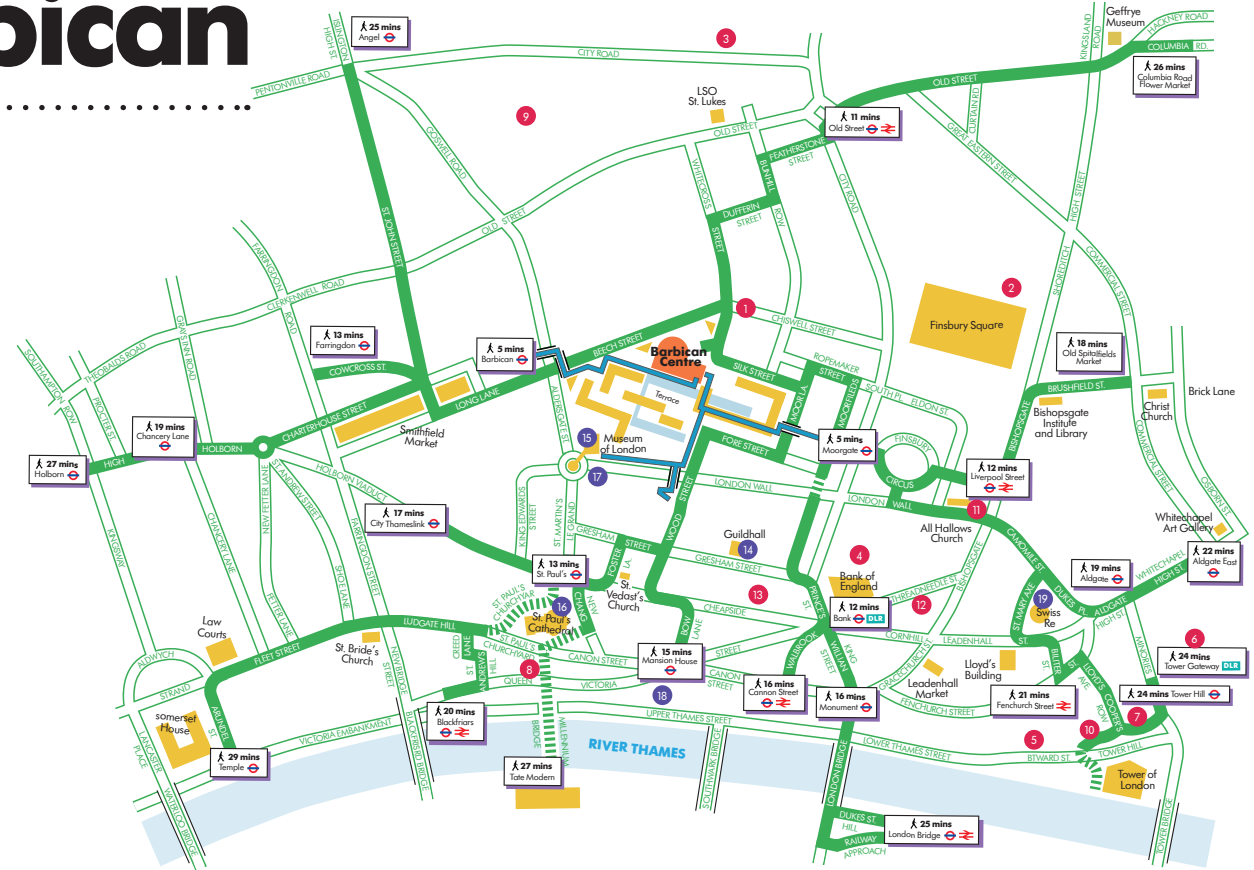
Following the official Working Safely during Covid-19 Government guidance, here are some of things we're doing to keep you safe:

- The Barbican is located in the heart of Central London within walking distance from several key landmarks and public transport hubs
- Easily accessed via public transport (TfL and National Rail)
