

Sound System Main PA

The main PA system consists of three clusters, Left, Centre and Right, together with fills, and flown Sub bass cabinets provide full and even coverage throughout the whole auditorium. All elements of the system are EQ'd and time aligned. The system has been set up with particular emphasis on good articulation of speech to every seat.

Control Equipment:

Sound can be controlled from either the Hall control rooms or with a desk situated at the rear of the Stalls. The Hall control room houses a DiGiCo SD9 digital mixing desk, to be operated only by Barbican technicians in the sound booth.

The standard front of house desk is a DiGiCo SD7 digital mixing desk c/w a standard 56 input 24 output digital Optocore rack is available only by prior arrangement and at additional package cost.

Standard Production Lighting

The standard FOH rig comprises a selection of Robert Juliat 611SX Profile's and ADB Warp/M. These Robert Juliat profiles can be coloured and focussed as required but cannot be rerigged or moved to different positions in the Hall. ADB Warp/Ms are automated profiles, with remote control of pan, tilt, zoom, shutter control and iris. These lanterns are to be used in open-white only and cannot be coloured-up.

Moving Light Rig

The moving light rig comprises Clay Paky K10 B-eye and K20 B-eye, Martin VIPER profiles, Robe POINTEs and Robe DLSs profiles. These units are only available by prior arrangement and at additional cost.

The main lighting desk in the Concert Hall is a grandMA2 and is controlled only by Barbican staff from the Hall control room, however the control desk can be re-positioned at the rear of the Stalls for client use, after prior arrangement.
