

Access information for National Open Youth Orchestra concert

The concert is on **Saturday 9 May 2020**.



The concert starts at **4pm** and finishes at **5pm**.



The concert will be at **Milton Court**. The address is:

1 Milton Street

London

EC2Y 9BH

This is not a part of the main Barbican complex.



This will be a **relaxed** performance. This means there will be space to **move** around and you can **make noise**. The **lights will be on** and you can **leave** the hall and **come back** in **whenever** you want.

About the venue, parking and arriving



The **nearest** car parks are at the **Barbican Centre**. The entrances to the car parks can be found on **Silk Street** **Beech Street**. They are only suitable for cars **under 1.8m** tall. They cost **£9** for any time period on Saturdays.



Blue Badge holders can park for **free** at the Barbican Centre by joining the **Access Membership Scheme**. You can **find out more** about **accessible parking** by visiting **here**: <https://bit.ly/2T9LA1T>.



There are **wider accessible bays** available in **car parks 3 and 5**. These can be **booked in advance**. There is more information **here**: <https://bit.ly/2T9LA1T>.



You can park on the **streets** nearby. It costs **£4** and you can park for **up to 2 hours**. You can find the **location** of on-street **blue badge spaces** on this **map**: <https://bit.ly/2TmtFgg>.



The **entrance** to Milton Court is **level** and there are **lifts** to get **between the floors**. It is on the **corner of Silk Street and Milton Street**.

About the venue, after arriving



The **box office** is on the **ground floor** and is right by the **main entrance**. You can go here if you need to collect your **tickets**.



There are **accessible toilets** on **each level**. They are located just around the corner from the box office, **next to the stairs and lift** on **ground level** and just around the corner from the bars on **Levels 1 and 2**.



The Barbican has **Changing Places** facilities in the **Foyer of cinemas 2 and 3** at the **Beech Street Cinema** complex. It is less than **300 meters** from **Milton Court**.



The **concert** will be in the **Concert Hall at Milton Court**. All **seating** will be in **the stalls**. This is on **Level 1**. You can use the **lift** to get there.



There will be a **chill-out** space available which you can access any time. There will be **signs** to show you where to go.

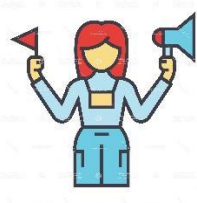
There will be a **BSL interpreter** who will **sign** what is said during the concert.



There is an **infra-red hearing loop** in the concert hall. You can ask for a **headset** from the **box office**.



When you book you can choose to book a space in the **relaxed seating area**. Here you can **stand, sit, lie down, move around** - whatever you want to do.



There will be a **pre-event tour** on **Sunday 3rd May** between **11am and 12:30pm**. This is for anyone who would like to **see the venue** before the concert. Please contact the **Milton Court box office** to find out more.



Assistance dogs are permitted throughout the venue.
